

Moses

Heb 11:24-25 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; (25) Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

1. Moses was born during a time of persecution (Exo 1:8-16)
2. His life was saved by the compassion of Pharaoh's daughter (Exo 2:1-10)
3. Moses committed murder and fled Egypt (Exodus 2:11-15)
 - a. Exo 2:11-15 And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren. (12) And he **looked** this way and that way, and when he saw that there was no man, he **slew** the Egyptian, and **hid** him in the sand.
 - b. (15) Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses **fled** from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.
4. When God called Moses out of the burning bush he was reluctant and made excuses (Exodus 3, 4)
 - a. no ability (3:11); no message (3:13); no authority (4:1); no eloquence (4:10); no desire (4:13)
5. Moses became one of the greatest leaders of all time - What made Moses such a great leader?
 - a. He obeyed God and did not fear man, leading them out of Egypt and through the wilderness.
 - i. He confronted Pharaoh with the 10 Plagues (Exodus 7-12)
 - ii. Exo 9:13-14 And the LORD said unto Moses, Rise up early in the morning, and **stand** before Pharaoh, and say unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, **Let** my people go, that they may **serve** me. (14) For I will at this time send all my plagues upon thine heart, and upon thy servants, and upon thy people; that thou mayest know that there is none like me in all the earth.
 - iii. He encouraged the people to trust God for deliverance and parted the Red Sea
 1. Exo 14:13-14 And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the **salvation** of the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever. (14) The LORD shall **fight** for you, and ye shall hold your peace.
 2. Exo 14:21-22 And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were **divided**. (22) And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground: and the waters were a **wall** unto them on their right hand, and on their left.
 - b. He was a servant - 42 verses reference Moses as a servant to God and his people
 - c. He led and judged an estimated 2 million+ people
 - i. He guided them spiritually (Exodus 19, 20)
 1. Exo 20:20 And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to **prove** you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye **sin** not.
 - ii. He overcame their stubbornness, complaints, & rebellions through prayer
 - iii. Exo 32:9-11 And the LORD said unto Moses, I have seen this people, and, behold, it is a **stiffnecked** people: (10) Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation. (11) And Moses **besought** the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why doth thy wrath wax hot against thy people, which thou hast brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?
