

The Life of Christ

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

1. Review
 - a. Jesus' Birth was promised by God throughout the Old Testament scriptures
 - b. Jesus was born of Mary who was a virgin and an honorable woman
 - c. Luke 1:37 For with God nothing shall be **impossible**.
2. The early life of Jesus
 - a. Jesus was worshiped as a baby and a toddler
 - i. Shepherds (Luke 2:15-17)
 - ii. The Wise Men
 1. **Mat 2:10-11** When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceeding great joy. (11)
And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.
 - b. Jesus learned at the temple and had a good reputation all his youth
 - i. Luke 2:46-52 (46) And it came to pass, that after three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both **hearing** them, and **asking** them questions. And all that heard him were astonished at **his** understanding and answers.
 - ii. (52) And Jesus **increased** in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man.
3. The ministry of Jesus
 - a. Jesus was Baptized by John
 - i. Mat 3:16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:
 - b. Jesus called and trained Disciples (Mat 4:18-24)
 - i. (19) And he saith unto them, **Follow me**, and I will make you fishers of men.
 - c. Jesus taught, preached, & performed miracles
 - i. Mat 4:23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, **teaching** in their synagogues, and preaching the **gospel** of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.
 - d. Jesus fulfilled 45 old testament prophecies
 - e. Jesus made prophecies, many concerning his own life, death, resurrection, and his second coming. Also the destruction of Jerusalem, the tribulation, armageddon, etc.
 - f. Jesus suffered (Luke 23)
