1. Review

- b. The epistles warn against following: A false gospel, false doctrines, false teachers, fake Christians, and religious salesmen that will turn your heart from the truth.

2. Encouragement Through Tough Circumstances

- a. God will be there for you through temptations
 - i. 1 Cor 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is **faithful**, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to **escape**, that ye may be able to bear it.
- b. God will be there for you when you are broken over your sins
 - i. 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to **forgive** us our sins, and to **cleanse** us from all unrighteousness.
- c. God will help you through stressful and emotionally taxing situations
 - i. Philippians 4:6-7 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. (7) And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall **keep** your hearts and **minds** through Christ Jesus.
- d. God will be there for you even when he does not heal us
 - i. 2 Cor 12:8-10 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. (9) And he said unto me, My **grace** is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. (10) Therefore I take **pleasure** in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

Rom 8:26-28 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our **infirmities**: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. (27) And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. (28) And we know that **all things** work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.
